

Aiken Polo Frequently Asked Questions

Can I purchase tickets in advance for Sunday polo?

Sunday polo admission is not available for advance purchase. Tickets may be purchased at the gate on the day of the match.

What happens if it rains?

Polo is dependent on field and weather conditions. If it is raining or the area has received significant rainfall, please call the polo hotline before heading to the field. Matches may be postponed or rescheduled when conditions are considered unsafe for horses or players.

What should I wear to polo?

There is no required dress code. Some guests enjoy dressing up for an afternoon at polo, while others prefer a more casual look. We recommend dressing comfortably and appropriately for the weather.

What time does the Pavilion open?

The Pavilion opens at 1:30 PM, with food and bar service beginning at 2:00 PM.

Is food available for purchase?

Yes. Food and bar service are available at the Pavilion beginning at 2:00 PM.

Can I bring my own food and beverages?

Yes. Guests in General Admission and tailgate areas are welcome to bring their own food and beverages. Outside food and beverages are not permitted inside the Pavilion which opens at 1:30 PM, and the bar and food are not available till 2:00 PM.

Can I bring my dog?

Yes. Well-behaved dogs are welcome but must remain on a leash at all times. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.

Can I set up a tent at my tailgate?

Yes. Tents are permitted at tailgate spaces but must be positioned at least 15 feet from the polo boards for the safety of guests, horses, and players.

Do I need to bring chairs for General Admission?

Yes. General Admission guests should bring their own chairs or blankets for seating.

Can I leave bagged trash at my tailgate?

No. We ask that all guests help us keep the polo grounds beautiful by taking all trash with them when they leave.
